The Maine Audubon Grants for Teachers Pilot Program (2017) offers funding up to \$1,000 per grant to Portland Public Schools teachers who seek to engage students with Maine Audubon programming during the 2017-18 school year. The partnership between Maine Audubon and Portland Public Schools has spanned over two decades and has benefited thousands of students. The establishment of an innovative pilot program administered by the Portland Education Foundation establishes a grant-making collaboration between Maine Audubon and PEF.

Applications Due: Friday, June 9, 2017
Decisions Posted: June 19, 2017

Please complete the online grant application at www.pefmaine.org no later than Friday, June 9, 2017 at midnight. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.

Grant guidance:

- 1) Grant funds can be used anytime during the 2017-18 school year;
- 2) Grant applications that plan for the use of funds in September, October and November 2017 will be prioritized;
- 3) Principal support is required;
- 4) A brief final report to PEF will be due soon after use of funds.
