



Menu of Services School Partnerships Programs

Maine Audubon is prepared to provide some or all of the following services during the 2018/2019 school year and beyond. This list is provided for planning purposes, and the costs listed are rough estimates.

Content training and coaching – Maine Audubon educators working with teachers to increase knowledge and understanding of key content areas including local wildlife food webs, particular ecological functions and citizen science.

- \$50 per hour for individual meeting and planning
- \$125 per hour for group workshops

Curricula planning and coaching – Maine Audubon educators working with teachers to develop specific lesson plans and teaching progressions, as well as to plan and resources specific activities.

- \$50 per hour for individual meeting and planning
- \$125 per hour for group workshops

Direct delivery support – Maine Audubon educators leading student field work and activities alongside teachers.

- \$250-750 per class (depending on number of students)

Landscape design and resourcing – drafting a garden design, coordinating installation and planting, advising materials sourcing, etc.

- \$50 per hour

Community education support – presenting at community meetings, advising on signage and graphics, leading stewardship activities, stakeholder development, etc.

- \$100 per hour

Other related fees/expenses – bus fees to Gilsland Farm or Scarborough Marsh, substitute teacher costs, etc.

- Check with your school's Principal or Community Coordinator

All above prices are estimates based on the single activities listed. Further customization and grouping of activities may result in efficiencies and reductions.
